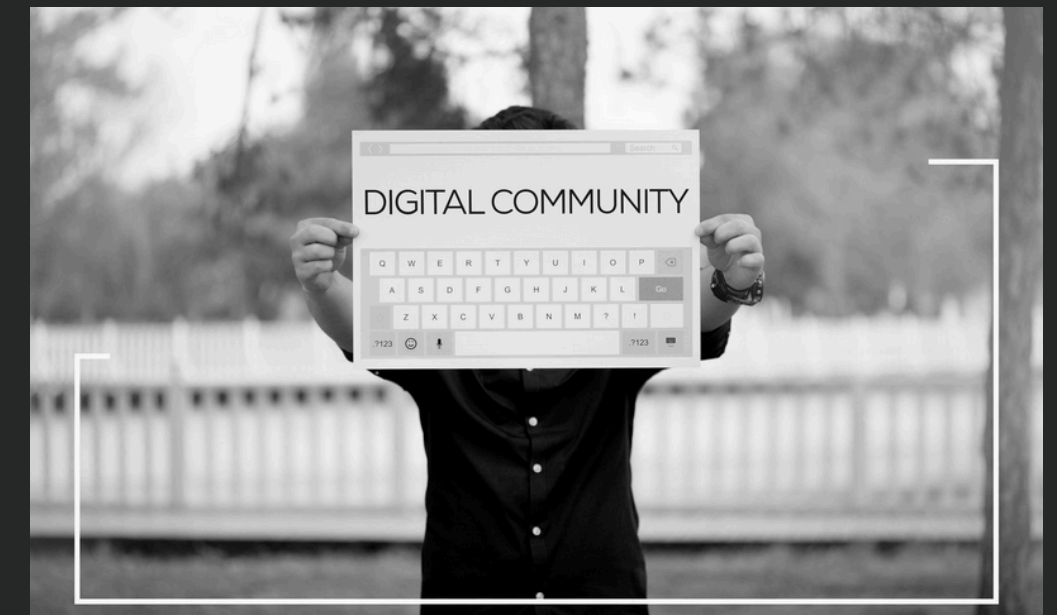
ANNUAL CONFERENCE
